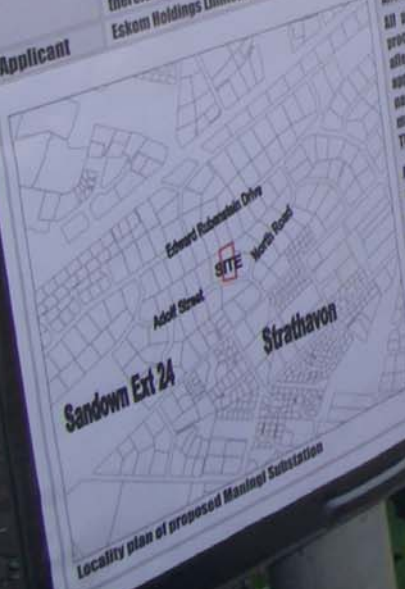


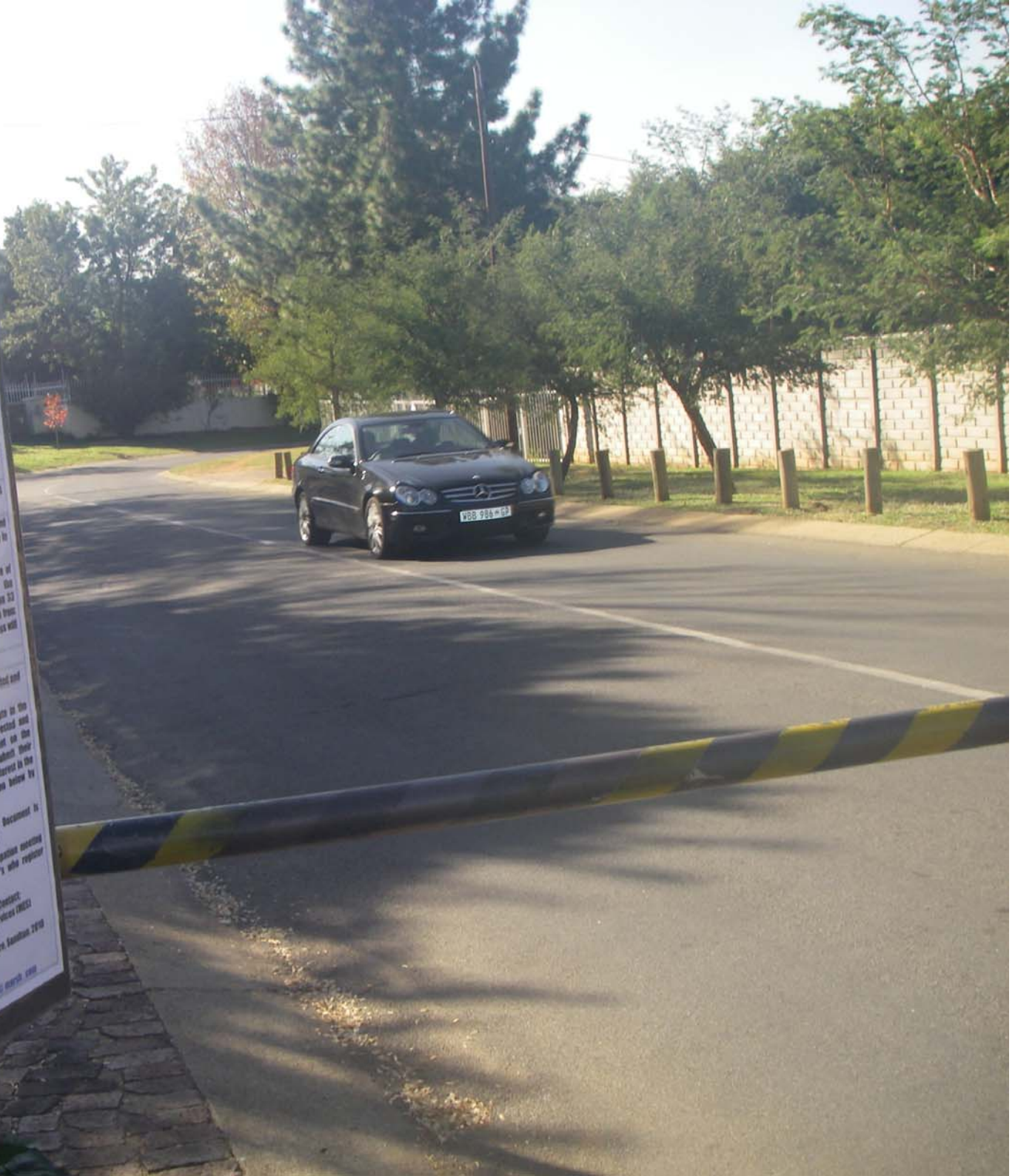
# NOTICE OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (EIA) PROCESS

Notice is given in terms of Regulation 56(2) of the Regulations published in Government Notice R 385 under Sections 24 of the National Environmental Management Act (Act no. 107 of 1998), of intent to carry out the following activity:

<b>Project</b>	The proposed development of an electrical substation required for the transmission and distribution of electricity. REF: Manning Substation
<b>Location</b>	The proposed development site is situated on Erf 304, Adolf Street in Sandown Extension 24, Sandton.
<b>Project Description</b>	The Applicant proposes to develop an electrical substation for the transmission and distribution of electricity due to an expected electricity load increase in the Sandton area in the near future. In terms of Government Notice R 306, the proposed activity involves the construction of facilities or infrastructure, including associated structures or infrastructure, for the transmission and distribution of electricity above ground with a capacity of more than 50 kilovolts and less than 120 kilovolts, (Activity VIII), and therefore requires substantive input from the Department of Environmental Affairs and Tourism (DEAT).
